### Discover MIA's sustainability choices

Be conscious of the choices and the sustainable organization of the event. In the Sustainability section of the miamarket.it website you will find all the information on our sustainability choices.

While staying in Rome, live your trip as sustainably as possible. You can get detailed information asking the Info-points in the city, the tourist office and at the accommodation facilities.

### Travel with sustainable public transports

Rome, especially in the city centre, is very simple to walk through. Moreover, it is equipped with a good metro service and bike rental points. For example, the Roma Termini train station is connected to the historical centre by a few minutes metro ride, (line A, Repubblica station), while from Palazzo Barberini, the centre can be reached with a pleasant 10 minutes walk.

#### Reuse, save, recover

The MIA organisation provides you with a complimentary reusable water bottle, that you can refill whenever you want from the fountains available at Palazzo Barberini and those scattered throughout the city. During your leisure and rest moments, we suggest you to engage in sustainable behaviours and to save water and energy at your accommodation facilities. If possible, avoid buying disposable products.

#### You can go there. But do others also go through it?

Pay attention to the effective practicability of the areas dedicated to access and transit for the disabled provided by the accessibility plan. Be careful where you leave your bike and how you park your car: a little carelessness on your part could cause great discomfort to others.
