The different situation gives Lasha a strong willingness to express the history of Georgian youth. That's why he chooses filmmaking. With many chances, he went to Tbilisi State University from 2005 to 2010 to study filmmaking as a director. During his study, with the help of his professor, he tries to find out his own language of cinema. By trying different way, his preference is always shooting non-professional actors with improvisational acting, which can show a powerful and realistic story. In 2013 he shot his first feature *I Am Beso* funded by the GNFC. The film premiered at the Sarajevo Film Festival, then won the Grand Prix at the Tbilisi Film Festival. In polls, the film is included in the twenty best Georgian films. Lasha's films are distinguished by their authenticity and sincerity.
