

MIA Co-Production Market & Pitching Forum FAQs

Who Can Apply?

Only main producers with a production company can submit a new entry to the MIA Co-Production Market & Pitching Forum 2025.

How many projects can I submit?

You may submit multiple entries, provided each meets the eligibility criteria. However, if more than one project submitted by the same production company (including co-productions) is selected, MIA and the Selection Committee reserve the right to give preference to only one project, in order to encourage the participation of a broader range of companies.

How much does submitting a project cost?

Submitting a project is free of charge.

What language should be used in the form?

All written materials must be submitted in English only.

Do you accept projects from anywhere in the world?

Yes. The Selection Committee will select up to 50 projects from all over the world.

Can I submit a project already selected at another Festival/Market?

Projects must not have been publicly pitched at any industry events, markets or festivals before MIA 2025. Single exceptions can be discussed with the Head of Co-Production Market for each category.

Is there an award?

Yes, the MIA Development Award. MIA will appoint a Jury of experts for each participation category of the award, who will select the winning project for each category (Animation, Documentary, Drama and Film) to which a cash prize of € 5,000.00 will be awarded.

When will you notify the selected projects?

Participants will be notified of the selection results by the end of August 2025.

If selected, will I need to come to Rome?

Yes. Once a project has been selected, at least one representative must be available to represent the project at the live public pitch and meeting sessions.

In case of non selection, will it be possible to receive specific feedback on my project?

Unfortunately, MIA is not able to provide detailed and specific feedback on projects that have not been selected.
